1. What is the new scoring system?

2. How to qualify to Secondary school?

Students will qualify for the respective courses as long as their PSLE Score meet the placement criteria.

N(A) / N(T)	25
N(T)	26 – 30, with AL7 or better in both English Language and Mathematics

3. Am I eligible to register to secondary in MWTI, if I get below 60% for my Total Religious subjects but my PSLE score is 24?

Based on the criteria given, not eligible. We would recommend the student to apply in government school for their secondary education.

4. If I my Total Religious subjects is below 50%, but my PSLE score is 30, what is my option?

MWTI does not provide any option to repeat Primary 6 due to limited resources. We would suggest the student to continue his/her secondary option in government school since he qualifies to be in N(T) if he gets AL7 or better in English and Mathematics.

5. What if I get 26 - 30 for my PSLE score but AL8 for English and/or Maths?

You are not eligible to be in the N(T) stream. You have to repeat your Primary 6 education in government school.

6. How to qualify to Secondary in Madrasah Wak Tanjong Al-Islamiah?

Admission is based on PSLE results, Al-Quran, Arabic and Total Religious subjects.

Students from MWTI

- 1. PSLE Results (PSLE Score of 24 or better).
- 2. Attain 60% or more for Total Religious subjects.
- 3. Attain 50% or more for Al-Quran and Arabic Language (either Nahu or Insyak).

Application Period

The application period is within one week from the day of release of PSLE Results on 25 November 2021 to 28 November 2021.

How to apply

(1) Application to Madrasah Wak Tanjong Al-Islamiah (MWTI)

Application is to be done strictly via Online Form. Application fee of \$10 is to be paid via online banking.

(2) Application to other Madrasah and other public schools

Applicants may visit the respective madrasah/school to apply.
